



GCS Home School Partnering Program School Year 2010-2011

Program overview-

The program is designed to provide enrollment opportunities for home-schooled students into the GCS Middle or High School programs. The program is offered for students in grades 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10. A goal of the program is to have students who enroll become full-time GCS students by their junior year. The GCS home school partnering program will not offer courses for students in grades 11 or 12.

Program specifics-

- A minimum of two classes must be taken to participate in the program.
- A student must take 3 or more classes to be eligible for either Middle or High School Fine Arts (drama, band, or choral).
- A student must take 3 or more classes to be eligible for GCS Middle School Athletics.
- A High School student enrolled in this program, due to NCISAA rule, cannot participate in GCS athletics.

Application and testing fee-\$140 per student
